I am trying to capture the life of my great-grandfather Jacob Jonsson, the most intelligent, goodhearted, energetic, loving man. In the summer of 1965 he was a geologist in the oil industry. After the U.S. dropped its atomic bomb in Hiroshima on Aug. 6, 1945, when I was still a boy, my grandfather had left the U.S. to return home to live out his life as a free person in the Soviet Union. I am going to draw this story as the world experienced the sixties. Now I have been told that this section will be a trip down memory lane. I am trying to get it right. My grandfather was a great leader. He is a real hero to me. I am going to tell his story. We will journey from the far north to the far south to the U.S. where he was born. It has been hard to find the right place and the right time for this story. I started this blog in May 2007 and it has taken me seven years to finish. I am not used to doing this. I only write five or six articles a year, but it is the year of my birth. I am not old enough to have been alive in the sixties. I have read the newspapers and magazines since I was a kid and I am not much of an historian. In reading my grandfather's journals and in reading his diaries, I have realized that his fears of death were very real. At the beginning of June 1965, he wrote in his diary: "I have a bad feeling about this trip. I feel my life is running out." He said that he felt "exhausted" in the diary on June 14. He wrote about receiving a letter from a woman whom he knew and about his fear that he had prostate cancer. He said that he wished to commit suicide. He noted that he feared for his girlfriend, who he referred to as "Miss Lola," and he feared for his great-grandchildren. His family was well off, and he had enough money to travel around the world.
